

## NEMBA Trail Grant Application

NEMBA grants provide financial support to enable individuals and groups to perform trail projects on public land in New England where mountain biking is allowed. Preference is given to mountain bikers whose projects build or improve share-use trails, but all projects will be considered. Grants may also be awarded to land managers and any non-profit organization. NEMBA grants are awarded twice a year, spring and fall.

If the applicant represents an organization, please include the cover copy of your IRS Determination letter. Applicants may also include pictures and diagrams of their proposed project but they are not required.

**Grant Amounts:** \$100 to \$500.

**Spring:** March 1 (Awarded March 20th) **Fall:** August 31 (Awarded September 15th)

Please return five (5) copies of your grant application. The application may be typed on a separate page, but must contain a brief section on each of the following. (Faxed or emailed applications will not be considered.)

**1) Project Description.** Why is the project beneficial and necessary? What trail problems will be addressed? (Be brief, but you may add an additional page if necessary).

2) **Budget**. Itemize the materials and costs of your project. Be as specific as possible.

3) **Submit Separately**:

a) **Map** of where the project is to take place.

b) **Letter of Support** from the land manager or management agency supporting and approving of your project.
